Who saith,

I am an electrician and have lived here for the past ten years.

On 1 July 44, I saw the body of a man hanging from an electric lamp standard in the PIAZZA DEL LEGNAME, MONTE SAN SAVINO. There was a rope around his neck which was secured to the crossbar of the lamp standard. His face was turned to the wall of the square and I could not see his features. He appeared to be dead.

Sometime during the middle of August 44, I was working at M. NALTIUCCI when I was approached by DEL BELLINO Argentina, who told me that she understood my father was present at an execution in MONTE SAN SAVINO on 30 June 44. She handed me a photograph of her husband which I later showed to my father SALVADORI Dante. He recognized the photograph as being that of the man whom he had seen being hanged in the PIAZZA del LEGNAME, MONTE SAN SAVINO on 30 June 44.

I later informed DEL BELLINO Argentina of what my father had said. I did not know the deceased man while he was alive.

I have read over this statement. It is correct and true. I herewith append my signature.
