STATEMENT OF 1-

CELATA ntonio, Pootor, Hospital of S. Maria della Face, Monte San Savino, Arezzo. Male 52 years.

Tho saith,

DELLA PARK and I have carried on this profession in WANTE SAME SAVING for the past fifteen years.

On the 11 July 44, I examined, in the mortuary soo of the hospital, a body, fully dressed, but in an advanced state of putrification.

I recognised the body as being that of CAHLET I Laigh aged 25 years, the son of Antonio, only by his clothing. I had known CARLETTI a long time, being a friend of the family.

I took outtings from the various garments and the shoes. These were identified by his father and GORI Line who had seen him during the period of his imprisonment in the Villa OANLITTI.

In no other way could evidence of identification of the body have been given owing to it's state of advanced putrification, all the soft tissues having been destroyed.

Examination of the body showed a bullet wound in the right calf and two bullet wounds in the region of the right side of the thorax.

All these bullets had passed through the body and could easily be seen by the position of the corresponding holes in the clothing.

ty that the wounds as described above were inflicted from behind, probably while OARLETTI Luigi was receining away.

The woundswhich council the death of CARLETTI are those in the region of the right and of the thorax already described.
