Who saith,

I am the wife of MANCINI GRIFFOLI Paolo and have lived here the last two years.

On 18 June 44, with my whole family, I left the house owing to the German troops moving into the house.

We returned to our house on Tuesday 4 July 44, I found upon my return that several German officers had occupied various rooms in my villa. They had written their names on several doors. Upon two of the doors there was the name of Major GRU, and another name was MOLDENHAUER.

These names were written in chalk and I have since had the door cleaned but the imprint of the writing still remains very clearly.

Owing to my being absent during the German occupation I know very little of the soldiers who resided there.

I have read over this statement. I read and understand English perfectly. It is correct and true. I herewith append my signature.
