STATEMENT OF:-

GIOVANNETTI Oscar, Male.
24, Civitella Della Chiana, Aged 37 years.

Who saith,

I am a carpenter and have lived at CIVITELLA all my life.

About 1600 hours on 27th July, 1944, I was in PIAZZA VITTORIO EMANUELE, CIVITELLA, where I saw a motor car. This car was cream coloured and of the Italian type for private use. The car contained two German soldiers who were requisitioning wireless sets in the village. I know this because they made me carry a radio set from the house of the arch-priest to their car. Consequently I was able to view the car in question and I remember it well. Today I was taken by Sgt. CLEWLOW of the British Special Investigation Branch to a farm near PIVRE A TRUCIANO where I saw the body of a private car. The body of this car resembled in colour and in detail that of the one I saw at CIVITELLA on 27th July, 1944.

I have read over this statement. It is true and correct. I herewith append my signature.
